Against the advice of the stable operator, the wrangler guide, and the insurance company, I am refusing the critical safety precaution.

- All riders must have a signed waiver
- Please wait on the front porch
- Approved riding helmets required, unless the hardhat waiver is signed by an adult
- All children must be at least 6 years old
- There is a 230 pound weight limit
- One person per horse, no double riding
- All trail rides are guided by one of our wranglers to insure your safety and fun
- Horses are to remain at a walk at all times
- While on the trail please keep your horse in a single file line
- Horses are not allowed to eat while on the trail, but can drink as much water as they want
- Always wait for a wrangler before getting on and off your horse
- No smoking on or around the horses
- Please remember screaming scares the horses
- Always keep ahold of your reins and your feet in the stirrups
- If you have a question or need help with anything please ask your wrangler
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone
